## **Meet Luca**



Luca's regaining his energy, and uses it to do anything and everything outdoors and active. He's planning on rejoining his hockey team in September and has been able to attend school again regularly. A social butterfly, he loves going to class and taking advantage of his outgoing personality. He's said his dream career is to help others as an oncologist after everything he's seen from the other side.

When Luca learned he would be granted a Wish, he was skeptical that it was real. The more he learned and the more he dreamed, however, he was overwhelmed with excitement. Never riding a plane before, he decided he needed to explore and experience a flight. He's decided to visit Disney World and to experience a ship-ride as well on a Disney cruise.
